

Information

Information counters can be found at several locations within the terminals. Help telephones and touch-screen information kiosks are also situated throughout the airport.

Transfer between Terminals

The free Skytrain service runs frequently between the terminals 1, 2, and 3, between terminals 2 and 4 runs a shuttlebus. Travellers connect the terminals to the transit areas.

Driving Directions

The East Coast Parkway toll road runs directly between the airport and Singapore city centre.

Rail

The MRT station is located beneath Terminals 2 and 3. It takes about 35 minutes to reach the city centre by train (with one change at Tanah Merah).

Bus

SBS Transit operate bus 36A and 26B, which run several times an hour between the airport and city centre destinations. The service departs from the airport basement of terminals 1, 2, and 3 and it takes about 60 minutes to get to downtown Singapore. Ticket machines on the bus don't give change so passengers are advised to get small denominations at the change machine in the arrivals halls.

Coach

A regular coach service leaves the airport for Johor Bahru, across the causeway in Malaysia (transtar.travel/cross-border-services).

Shuttle

Shared-ride shuttle buses run between the airport and city centre hotels (tel: +65-624/138 18 or see t3airportshuttle.com.sg).

Taxi

Taxi ranks are situated outside the arrivals hall and are available 24 hours a day. The journey to the city takes around 30 minutes.

Car Parking

There are several car parks at Singapore Changi Airport. For more information please see the airport's website (changiairport.com).

Bureaux de change kiosks are open 24 hours a day and are located in all terminals. Banks and ATMs are also available throughout the airport.

Food

Singapore Changi Airport has many restaurants, cafés, bars, delis, fast-food outlets and snack bars, offering both Western and Asian cuisine. Many of these eateries are open 24 hours a day.

Shopping

There are numerous shops at Singapore Changi Airport, including duty-free outlets and 24-hour mini-supermarkets in all terminals. Other retailers sell a range of items, from the latest fashion to specialist local produce.

Luggage

Left-luggage services are available in all terminals. The information and customer service counters can be approached about lost and found items, or alternatively, passengers should contact the relevant airline. Porters are on hand to assist passengers with baggage (for a fee).

Other

The airport is home to a number of well-equipped transit lounges. The airport is

also home to themed gardens, a swimming pool and fitness centre.

Other facilities include walk-in medical clinics, a 24-hour medical emergency centre (tel: +65-654/322 23), pharmacies and a multi-faith prayer room. Baby-change rooms and children's play areas are also available.

Conference & Business

There are business lounges within the transit hotels in terminals 1, 2 and 3.



Accessibility

Singapore Changi Airport has level access, lifts, ramps and accessible toilets. A 24-hour wheelchair hire service is available from the medical centres (Tel. +65-654/31 11 18)– passengers requiring special assistance should inform their airline prior to travel.
