Information

There are information desks in each terminal. Information telephones are located at various points with the terminals and operate 24 hours a day. Tourist information is available from a kiosk on the second level of the International Terminal.

Transfer between Terminals

A free shuttle bus operates between the International Terminal and domestic terminals.

How to get there

Driving Directions

From central Tokyo, the airport complex is reached via the Metropolitan Expressway No. 1 Haneda Route and then the Bayshore route, which passes the airport terminals.

Bus

Numerous scheduled bus routes link the airport with many destinations in and around Tokyo, a list can be found on the airports' website (tokyo-airport-bldg.co.jp). Tickets must be purchased before boarding from the desk in Arrivals, with bus stops immediately outside the terminal.

Taxi

Taxis are readily available outside the terminal buildings. Taxis operate on a set fare basis. The journey time to central locations is 25 to 40 minutes, depending on traffic.

Car Parking

Short and long-term parking is available at all three terminals – shuttle buses provide links to the car parks. Full details are available on the airport website or from the airport parking offices (tel. +81-3/57 57 81 91 or +81-3/57 57 94 98 for Domestic Passenger Terminal 1; +81-3/64 28 94 98 for Domestic Passenger Terminal 2; +81-3/64 28 01 21 for International Passenger Terminal).

Facilities & infrastructure

Money

ATMs are available both airside and in public areas of the terminals. Banks with currency exchange facilities can be found in each terminal. Additional bureaux de change can be found throughout the International Terminal.

Communications

Public telephones are situated at key points throughout the terminals. Wi-Fi internet access is free, but there are also fixed internet stations scattered throughout the airport. Mobile phone hire shops can provide local SIM cards and telephones.

Food

There is a wide choice of cafés, bars and restaurants offering both Japanese and international cuisine. There is a particularly large selection of eateries on the fourth level of the International Terminal, ranging from small sushi bars to a French bistro.

Shopping

Duty-free shopping is available for international passengers in the departure International Terminal. Gift shops offer a range of local and international items, souvenirs and branded gifts, and there are also outlets selling convenience goods.

Luggage

Luggage lockers are available, as is porter assistance and a luggage delivery service. A lost luggage service operates from a desk on the ground floor of Terminal 1.

Other

Baby changing facilities are available throughout the airport. There are first aid stations in Terminal 1 and the International Terminal.

Conference & Business

There is a choice of airport lounges with business facilities, one of which is open 24 hours a day in the International Terminal and offers several small meeting rooms (tel: +81-3/64 28 06 77). Meeting space is also available in Terminal 1. A wider choice of business services and conference space can be found in some of the hotels in and around the airport.

Accessibility

Tokyo Haneda Airport offers a range of facilities for the disabled, including in-terminal transportation, hearing loops and designated parking spaces. The terminals are fully accessible to wheelchair users, who can request wheelchair hire at the information desks (tel: +81-3/64 28 08 88).
