## General info

**Airport Code:** TIV

**Number of Terminals:** 2

An airport information desk is located in the entrance hall of Terminal 1 (Tel:+382-32/67 13 37). There is also a tourist information counter in the arrivals area.



## How to get there

### Driving Directions

The airport is located south of Tivat on the Adriatic Highway (Jadranska magistrala), and the signs are easy to follow.

### Taxi

Taxis can be booked at the taxi counter in the arrivals area of Terminal 1.

### Bus

From the bus stop, which is about one kilometer away from the terminal, passengers can travel to almost any town or city in Montenegro.

Buses to coastal tourist destinations and to neighboring countries also stop here. For information about routes and schedules, visit [busticket4.me](http://busticket4.me) ([busticket4.me](http://busticket4.me)). This site can also be used to make direct bookings with various bus companies.

### Car Parking

Although Tivat Airport does not have its own parking lot, there is a publicly accessible paid parking lot next to the airport. There are special rates for long-term parking. Please inquire in person at the parking lot.



## Facilities & infrastructure

### Money

There are ATMs in the arrivals area of Terminal 1.

**Communications**

Free Wi-Fi Internet access is available in the terminal buildings.

**Food**

In the publicly accessible area of Terminal 1, there is a café for passengers and visitors. In the parking lot opposite Terminal 2, there is a café/restaurant that serves meals and drinks.

**Shopping**

In Terminal 1, there are numerous small shops selling newspapers, travel essentials, souvenirs and perfumes. Duty free shopping is available.

**Luggage**

The lost and found office is located in the arrivals hall of Terminal 1 (Tel: +382-32/67 09 13). It is open daily from 7 am and closes after the last flight of the day arrives.

**Other**

Beyond the security-check area in Terminal 2, there is a smoking area. Car rental desks can be found in the arrivals area of Terminal 1.

**Accessibility**

Passengers with limited mobility are requested to inform their airline in advance about any special requirements they may have. Airport staff will be happy to assist passengers. There are wheelchairs and other facilities available for passengers with limited mobility.
