How to get there

Driving Directions

From the center of Baku, take the Airport Road to the northeast. This leads to the suburb of Bina and directly to the airport.

Bus

Buses operated by Aero Express (aeroexpress.az) connect Heydar Aliyev International Airport with the 28 May metro station and the Central Railway Station. The buses run 24 hours a day about every half hour. The ride takes about 30 minutes.

Taxi

Officially licensed taxis are available outside Terminal 1. The way to the taxi waiting area is marked with "Official Taxi" signs. Remember, though: It's not customary to pick a cab yourself. "Taxi marshals," uniformed employees of taxi companies, wait for passengers and assign them a car.

Car Parking

There are about 600 long-term and short-term parking spaces directly in front of the terminals. There are payment machines on-site, and they only accept cash (banknotes).

ATMs can be found in the arrivals area of both terminals. There is a currency exchange office on the first floor of each terminal.

Communications

Free Wi-Fi Internet access is available throughout the airport. There are public telephones and a post office.

Food

There are plenty of cafes, bars and fast food restaurants before and after the security check.

Shopping

Duty-free goods can be purchased in the international departures area. In both terminals, there are a number of other shops selling regional products, luxury goods, souvenirs, stationery, magazines and books.

Luggage

Baggage carts are available for use in the terminals. You can book the services of the luggage carriers in advance (reservations@vipavia.az).

Other

Other facilities at Baku Airport include changing rooms, a medical emergency service and a prayer room in the departures area. There is a small library behind the security checkpoint near Xurcun Café.

Conference & Business

Quiet working environments are available in several of the lounges. A business center is provided in the Sheraton Hotel at the airport (sheraton-airport.hotels-baku.com).

**Accessibility**

The airport is completely accessible with elevators, ramps, escalators and wheelchair-accessible toilets. Disabled parking spaces are located directly in front of the terminal entrances. Passengers who need further assistance should contact their airline in advance of their trip.
