Information

Information desks are located in each terminal. Additionally, information kiosks with touch-screen technology can be found in all the terminals. P.I.T. (Punto di Informazione Turistica, tel: +39-06/65 95 36 40) provides on-site tourist information.



How to get there

Driving Directions

The A90 ring road, which skirts Rome, leads to the E80/A91 highway that goes directly towards Rome Leonardo da Vinci-Fiumicino Airport; from here, passengers should follow signposts to the terminals.

Rail

The Leonardo Express train service runs every 30 minutes to Rome's Termini railway station (journey time: 35 minutes). FL1 local trains operate every 15 minutes and stop at local stations on the way to Tiburtina Station (journey time: 30 minutes). Services also run to Fara, Sabina, Poggio, Mirteto and Orte.

Bus

COTRAL buses take around an hour to reach the city centre (tel: +39-800/17 44 71; cotralspa.it).

Taxi

Taxis are readily available outside the terminals; passengers are advised to only take a white licensed metered taxi.

Car Parking

Multi-storey car parks A to D are directly linked to the terminals via pedestrian walkways. There are limited spaces at Terminal A and B for short-stay parking. The long-term car park on the motorway from Rome to Fiumicino is served by a free shuttle bus to/from the terminals – covered long-term parking is also available. Additional facilities include a car valet service. Parking can be booked in advance via the airport's website.

**Facilities & infrastructure****Money**

Banks, bureaux de change and ATMs are located in the terminals.

Communications

Wi-Fi internet access is provided throughout Rome Leonardo da Vinci-Fiumicino Airport. Postal services are also available.

Food

There is a wide range of food and drink outlets both before and after the security checkpoints in terminals T1, T2 and T3.

Shopping

Shops at Rome Leonardo da Vinci-Fiumicino Airport include duty-free outlets (for passengers travelling outside the EU), fashion boutiques, jewellers and perfume retailers. Shops selling traditional Italian products can also be found in the airport. The majority of shops are located in terminals T1 and T3.

Luggage

A left-luggage service is available in T3, International Arrivals. For items lost at the airport, contact the airport office (Aviation Services, tel: +39-06/83 39 44 44).

Other

A first aid facility (tel: +39-06/65 95 31 33) is available 24 hours a day. A chapel, prayer room and nurseries are also located within the airport.

Conference & Business

Meeting and conference facilities are available at the on-site Hilton Rome Airport Hotel (tel: +39-06/65 258), a short distance from the terminals.



Accessibility

Disabled passenger lounges are located in all terminals. Parking spaces for those with disabilities are available in the long-term car park. When booking a flight, those with disabilities are asked to specify the type of assistance required.
