## Facilities & infrastructure

### Money

Landsbankinn bank has two branches at Keflavík International Airport, one in front of the arrivals hall and the other in the departures hall; the latter also provides bureau de change services. In addition, there are several ATMs in the terminal.

### Communications

There are two postboxes in the terminal building. Paid-for Wi-Fi access is available in all the principal waiting, restaurant and bar areas. Internet services are also available via internet kiosks located throughout the terminal complex.

### Food

A bistro restaurant, a panoramic bar and several cafés are located in the departures area.

### Shopping

There is a choice of duty-free shops at Keflavík International Airport, with a range of products on offer, including cosmetics, alcohol, confectionery, tobacco, books, magazines, jewellery, watches and electrical products. There are also shops selling Icelandic crafts, woollen items, souvenirs and local food and drink products.

### Luggage

For items lost in the arrivals or departures halls, contact the lost and found office (tel: +354 420 1808), which is run by airport police. For items lost or found during travel, contact the relevant airline.

**Other**

The Icelandair (tel: +354 425 0220) travel agency is located in the departure hall.

**Conference & Business**

There is a business lounge on the second level of the terminal. Meeting rooms are available at some local hotels, including the nearby Hotel Keflavik (tel: +354 420 7000; [www.hotelkeflavik.is](http://www.hotelkeflavik.is)).

**Accessibility**

Accessibility is good at Keflavik International Airport. There are adapted toilets and lifts for wheelchair users. Wheelchair assistance is available with notice of at least 48 hours (tel: +354 425 6500). Any passengers who may require additional assistance are advised to contact their airline before travelling.
