The airport information desk is centrally located in the public area.



## How to get there

### Driving Directions

From central Thessaloniki, follow the A24 freeway south, then turn right onto the A67 at the exit signposted "Aerodromiou Thessalonikis," which takes you straight to the airport.

### Bus

Direct bus services – the number 78 bus by day and the 01N by night ([oasth.gr](http://oasth.gr)) – operate every 30 minutes from the bus stop outside the check-in hall at the airport to the train station in the center of Thessaloniki. The journey takes roughly 45 minutes. Taxis (including Radiotaxi, tel: +30-23/10 55 05 00) are available outside the airport.

### Taxi

Metered cabs operate from immediately outside Arrivals and can take passengers directly to the city centre (journey time: 20-25 minutes).

### Car Parking

The airport has well over 1400 parking spaces, of which 28 are designated for disabled drivers. (For details, call tel.: +30-23/10 98 53 41).



## Facilities & infrastructure

### Money

Several banks offering currency exchange facilities can be found in the main hall of the airport, and a bureau de change is located in Arrivals. A number of ATMs are provided in various locations throughout the terminal building.

### Communications

There is a post office located within the airport and public telephones are strategically placed throughout. Wi-Fi access is also available.

#### **Food**

There are several restaurants and bars within the terminal, some of these have views overlooking the runways.

#### **Shopping**

Duty-free is available in Departures for passengers leaving the EU. Goods offered include the usual mix of alcohol, tobacco and cosmetic goods, along with local wine, confectionery and general souvenirs.

#### **Luggage**

There are no left luggage facilities at the airport, but free trolleys are provided.

#### **Other**

Other facilities at Thessaloniki International Airport include baby-care rooms and a children's play area.

#### **Conference & Business**

There are currently no meeting facilities at the airport, however there are two VIP lounges in Departures which provide a quiet working environment for passengers. Extensive business facilities are however available at the Ambassador Hotel (tel: +30-239/20 21 20 03; ambassador.gr) located only a short distance from the airport.



### **Accessibility**

The airport is fully accessible to passengers with reduced mobility with lifts between floors and specialised toilet facilities. Any passengers who may require additional assistance are advised to contact their airline before travelling.
